EVICTION PREVENTION ASSISTANCE

What is it?

This program provides rental, mortgage, and/or utility payment assistance to low-income households within the City of Redlands whose income has been negatively impacted by COVID-19.

Eligibility Requirements

- At risk of homelessness in the city of Redlands
- Low-income (up to 80% AMI/Area Median Income)
- Facing COVID-19-related delinquencies

Required Documentation

- Eviction or past due notice / utility shut off notice
- Proof of income within the last 30 days
- Verification of loss of income due to COVID-19

How to Apply
